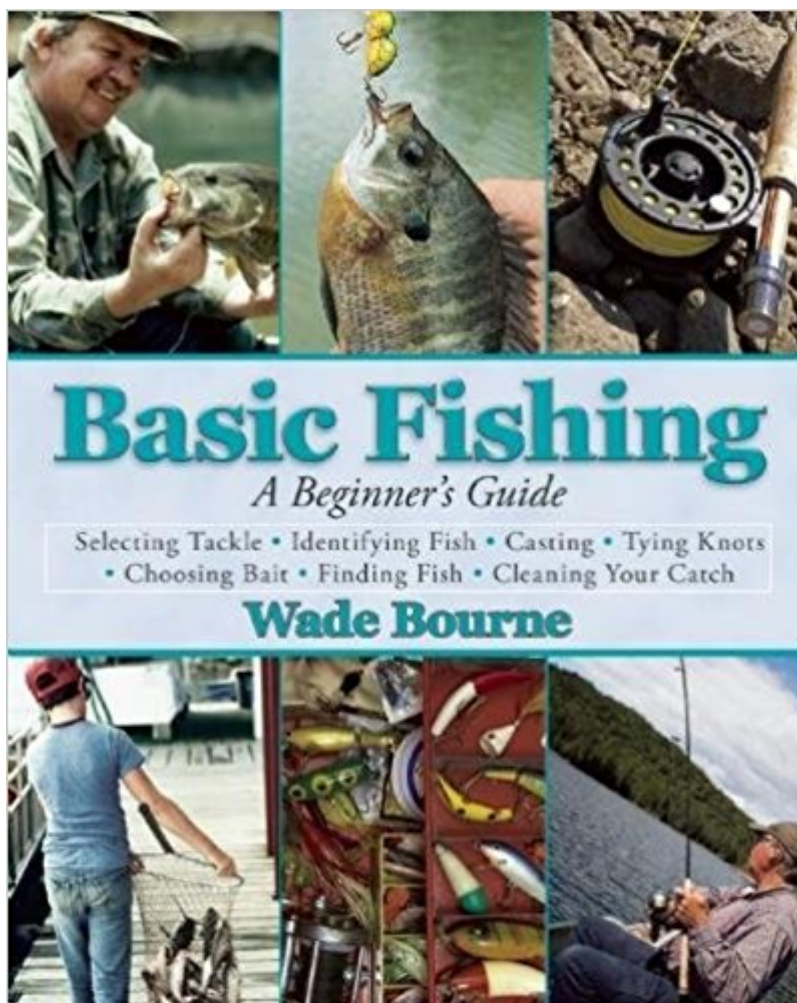

A veteran television broadcaster, he has hosted a weekly hunting and fishing series for several years. He is the author of six books on hunting and fishing and contributes to several leading outdoor magazines. He lives in Clarksville, Tennessee.

He has a very relaxed writing style and I feel we are having a talk instead of reading a book. He talks about catching a variety of fish under different conditions, admitting that lots of people fish lots of different ways and some work and some don't. He is increasing your odds by explaining how to pick the right spot, where the fish hang out (top of lake, bottom feeder, fast current, still waters), and what they like to eat. I look forward to trying his advise.

This book is put together very well. Takes you from common knots a beginner will need to basic techniques. If your just starting out in your Angler hobby this book will help. I highly recommend it. I think what I liked the most out of this book was the way the author explains how to study a body of water and try and determine where the fish may be and where not to waste your time. He explains how fish act in their enviroment which helped a beginner like myself know where Not to cast my lures.
