

I usually enjoy Elizabeth Peter's books and find them delightful opportunities to get away from the hum drum of everyday life. This particular book, however, is not one of my favorites. The flow of the story is uneven due to constant change in the 1st person speaker. The narration comes from several different characters in the book and without clear differentiation. The exploration of the tombs is historically interesting, but "Tomb" is overly weighted with historical details which, in the end, detract from the story itself.

I always enjoy Elizabeth Peters' works, and Barbara Rosenbladt is wonderful as the narrator. The Tomb of Tutankhamen has fascinated people since it's rediscovery in 1922, and the first-hand telling of the story was very enjoyable. My greatest wish is to visit Egypt and see all the great sights, which seems more and more unlikely with the unrest going on, and reading or listening to Ms. Peters' novels is a good vicarious way to enjoy them. My great regret is that we will have no more Amelia Peabody Emerson stories from this wonderful writer.

I own all the books in the Amelia Peabody series and they are all good. Getting to know the

characters through 18 books is such a pleasure and while initially I was not interested in the Egyptian culture I have grown fascinated with setting of these books. Start at the beginning of the series though to really enjoy the stories. (Crocodile in the Sandbank)Elizabeth Peters also writes another series - Vickie Bliss, which take place in the present day. They are a fun read, too.Lastly, both the Amelia Peabody and Vickie Bliss series are available as an audiobook and they are read by one of the best readers I have heard - Barbara Rosenblatt. You will love hearing this series read to you by Ms. Rosenblatt. Her accents, abilities to change from men and women's voices, and pronoucing all the unusual words is a delight to listen to.
