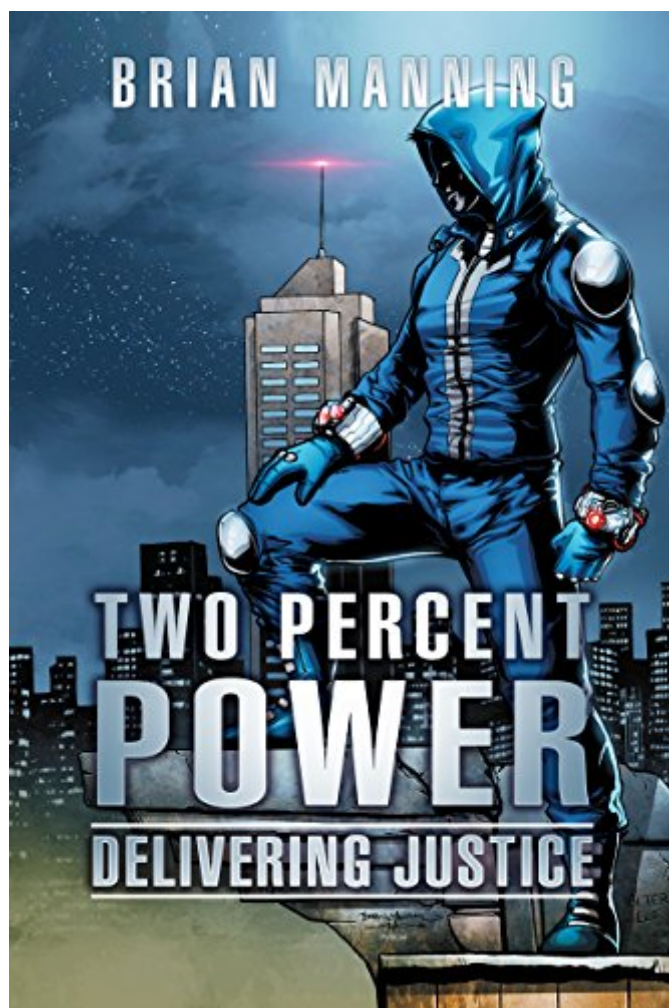

It seems like it would be a ridiculous story, a hero with the ability to telekinetically manipulate milk,

some sort of parody story about how ridiculous superheroes are. But that's not the case at all. This is a very entertaining street-level hero book that nicely straddled the line between fun and realism when it comes to the powers and how they worked. Patrick and his friends get knocked around in their fights, but the damage is seldom lasting, and ultimately they get their happy ending, complete with the hint that there's more to it all. The heroes are nuanced. The villains are a bit more one-dimensional, because we seldom get a good focus on them, but we get the implication that most of them have a life outside of their villainy, and two of them are given sympathetic motives for their actions. I'm trying to think of something concrete to complain about to justify the four star rating, but I honestly can't think of anything. The book is solid. The editing was amazingly professional. I don't think I spotted a single typo. The fight scenes actually felt fairly real despite the superpowers with moves being called out on occasion and realistic treatment of the difficulty of fighting mobs and the progressive damage one accrues even when winning. Really, the only things that jumped out at me was the lack of adults in the lives of any of these kids, and how the whole superpowers thing is implied to be omnipresent, but also doesn't seem to have made much of an impact on the world. I'm keeping this author on my radar, hoping that the second book in the series is as good.

The most unique super hero inspired novel I've read in years. Cool cheeky characters wise cracking pun artists and sarcastic quips abound. Dialogue rings true to how me and my friends talk to each other as we poke fun and chuckle. Unique powers and motivations run rampant throughout. Very hard to put down, very. I spent many nights reading it long past my bed time with a constant grin at the banter peppered with chuckle and occasional belly laughs. A must read. This author is going places I truly believe that. Great read!
