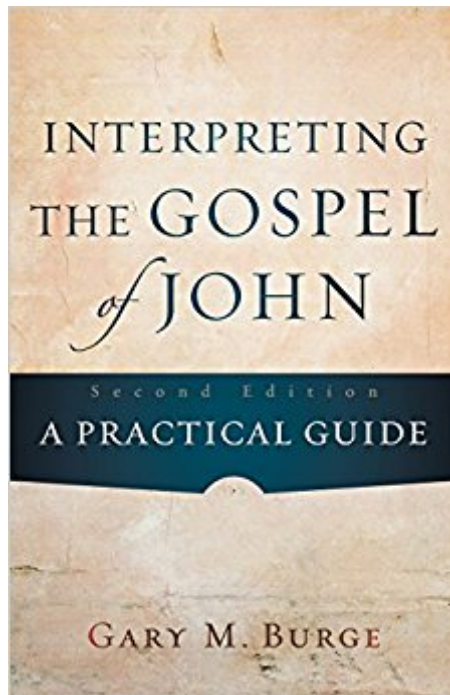




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Interpreting The Gospel Of John: A Practical Guide

Author Gary Burge has completed a good work in this Guide. Of interest to me was chapter 3 "How the Fourth Gospel Was Built" that addresses the literary seams. These form a major obstacle to interpretation of John 15-17, which is not directly addressed by the Author. I have maintained these three chapters are a 'hysteresis' (using E.W. Bullinger's term) or a presentation of information previously given but not publicly disclosed until now. The gospel records of Matthew, Mark, and Luke tend to support his position, and when applied, provide clarity to the issue of literary seams.
