

You really do reap what you sow, but we have a higher ability through God's Spirit in us to reflect forgiveness, patience and love we so much want and need from others but need to humbly receive for ourselves first. I'm only eight chapters in, but already I am seeing a positive change by applying the truths that Gary Thomas has laid out in this book. Everything is so plain and transparent.
