

As a homeschooling mom of five kids, I thought I would be buying one of these for each of my students. The first half of this massive book is for teacher use. It has review questions, additional resources, and activities to include in your lesson plans. The second half is the student pages. I've decided to keep only one copy for myself to use in lesson planning, and return the rest. For families with more than one child, the student pages can either be copied or purchased separately from the publisher printed or in PDF format. I really wish the teacher's materials had been printed in the hardcover text rather than this activity book, that way parents could purchase one "teachers book" and as many "student books" as they need.

My son enjoys the activities and I like how there are multiple options for different ages. Lots of suggested reading for library trips and the maps are a nice addition.

This book is quite large but good. It has neat crafts to do for each chapter of the correlating book. I especially like the recipes in it. Also some nice map work, comprehension questions & coloring pages. Not great for really young kids but 2nd ish grade is just fine, maybe younger depending on how much of the book you use. I love that this book gives you things to do that are hands on, which helps reinforce what you are reading and I'm not left wondering what to do for an activity. If you are using the story book that goes with this one and want more, this is a nice thing to buy.
