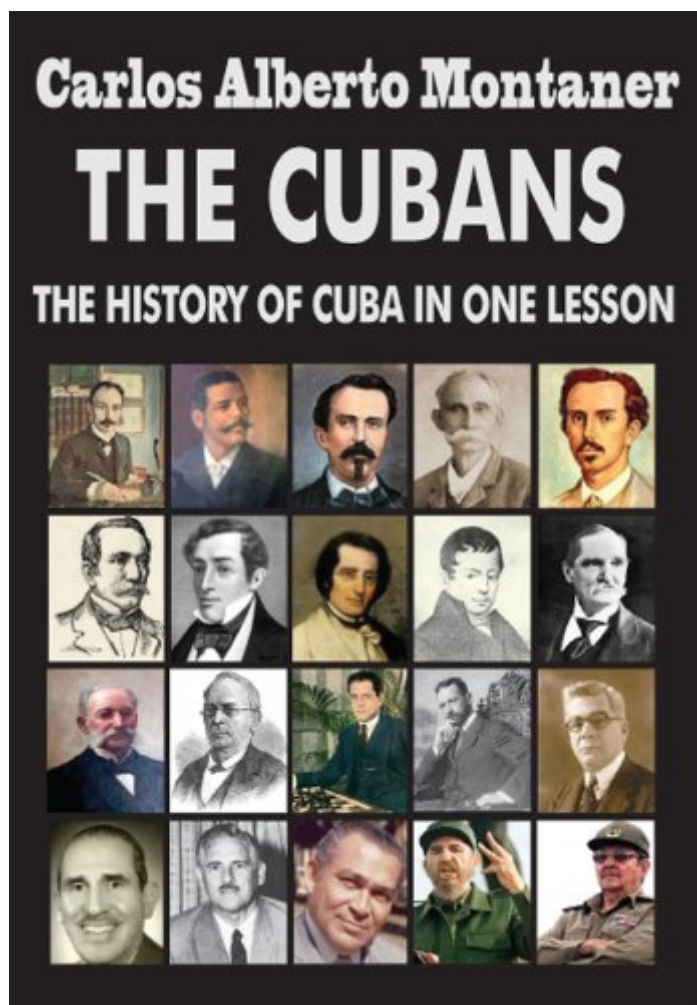

Quick overview and is quite current, which is good. The Kindle version appears to be done as a series of page photos, so you have very limited functionality, eg. cannot lookup definitions, cannot resize text (except by clicking on the page and expanding it as a picture expansion), etc.
