

I have read over 20 dog training books in the last couple of decades and I have to say that I think Carol Benjamin's method is just brilliant. Her understanding of dog nature is intuitive and extraordinarily helpful. She writes very clearly and teaches not only the "how" but the "why". In many ways it is a dog psychology book that has helped me to train my dogs in a very elegant way and feel more connected to them than I knew was possible.

I think this is one of the best books on puppy raising. In fact this is the 3rd couple I have purchased. (Gave the others to new puppy owners.)Our Shiba's are such an old breed that they respond to pack behavior more then any other training technique.

It is a bit out of date and there are newer methods of training being used that might be better but it has some good tips about how to interact with your dog effectively.

This is by far the best puppy training book I've seen. It's very easy to follow. I prefer to train my puppy's commands in a slightly different order than they are presented in the book and I think the command "Wait" would be better to use on very young puppies than the more rigid "Stay", but I have found it to be very helpful. Clicker training is not discussed but fits in well with her instructions. I would suggest you read this book BEFORE you bring your puppy home and refer to it often while

training her.

This is a good book to add to my library as a new owner of a puppy. I also like "Monks of New Skete" puppy training whose book actually mentioned this one as more reading. Between those two books I feel I have gained a good insight to puppy behavior. The methods work. We have more work to do, but it will be worth it to have an obedient and well-adjusted dog in the end. They have a common sense approach with dog behavior knowledge added in. I would have not been able to figure these things out on my own.

Bought this very book in 1985 for our first puppy...loved it ever since. Moved, lost it, and just had to replace it for our two new puppies! The advice is practical and down to earth. It contains great ideas and suggestions for training your puppy.
