

Its a factual book that's worth the read

There are no shocking revelations, no explosions or running battles in this book - and that's what makes it so fascinating. With lots of beautiful pictures and thoughtful commentary about the quiet moments and the daily life in the middle of a war, this book brings home the little things and the quiet moments, the glimpses of heart and soul of our soldiers, our allies, and the land in which they live.

The book was good and a great opportunity to see things not often seen, but some of the pictures disappointed me. I am guessing that they are the best that could be done in a bad situation, but I would have liked to see better. Plus, the pictures orientation did not match the book's.

Free on a Kindle, however, the photographs are made monochrome and shrunk. So it loses a lot on my Kindle. At least the photographs are included in the Kindle file. I do like the pictures of common everyday things as Iraq was working to get away from the terrorism. A good reminder of what life can and should be like for people of the country.

The problem is that some photos are 90 degrees rotated, regardless of how you orient the Kindle. You either have to partially tilt the Kindle and your head, or you have to lay the Kindle flat. Otherwise I really appreciated the photos and commentary.
