Q. Are TCAs more effective for severe depression than SSRIs? **A.** No large studies fully justified. Although there is general evidence that TCAs may be more effective to severe depressive depression in the elderly (Pies et al. 1999), the majority of studies have not established any overall superiority of the TCAs when compared with the SSRIs (Kernberg 1995). In my experience, however, a TCA often will be effective in older patients who have failed trials on more than one SSRI. **Q.** Are there any significant interactions between lithium and antidepressants? **A.** There are no clinically significant pharmacokinetic interactions, although lithium disposition levels may be slightly increased by the lithium carbamoyl preparation; this increase may be due to neutralization of lithium and by the carbamoyl form of lithium (Brennan et al. 1999). If these effects do not appear to be significantly increased by the combination versus lithium alone, sedation is necessarily increased. **Q.** Can risperidone be used in the treatment of psychosis in patients with Parkinson's disease? **A.** There are conflicting data on the benefits of risperidone in psychosis pa-
