

Phil Mickelson followed an outstanding amateur career with a brilliant assault on the PGA Tour, compiling 36 PGA Tour victories by 2009 (second among active players), including three major championships: the Masters Tournament in 2004 and 2006 and the PGA Championship in 2005. He has played on seven U.S. Ryder Cup teams and seven U.S. Presidents Cup teams. Mickelson is in the prime of his career, and his short game is without peer in golf today.

I'm a fairly new golfer (only 5 years) and a lefty to boot. It's hard finding advice for left handers and most golf instruction books cater to driving and swing mechanics. Phil, shares his years of winning experience in an easy to understand way. Some of which contradicts some other instructors time honored advice, but who can argue with his results. This book is also applicable to right handed players.

This book is valuable because it has excellent pictures combined with descriptions of the pictured technique. There are points here for everyone but readers should keep in mind that Phil Mickelson is a professional golfer who has developed and honed his technique through now a couple decades of play and surely thousands of hours of practice. Interestingly, the book criticizes (indirectly) the short game system taught by Dave Pelz, who has served as Mickelson's short game strategy coach for a few years now. Avid golfers will find this useful.

This is a great book with great illustrations. The video is also excellent. It offers a fresh approach and one that is different than what I had found in others books.

I have always been taught to have an open stance when chipping and sweeping the hands through, but after reading about the "hinge and hold" method and squaring your feet to the line, I immediately started hitting chips which were always on target. The entire book is full of such instruction. There is no doubt reading this book will help this, the most important part of your game!
