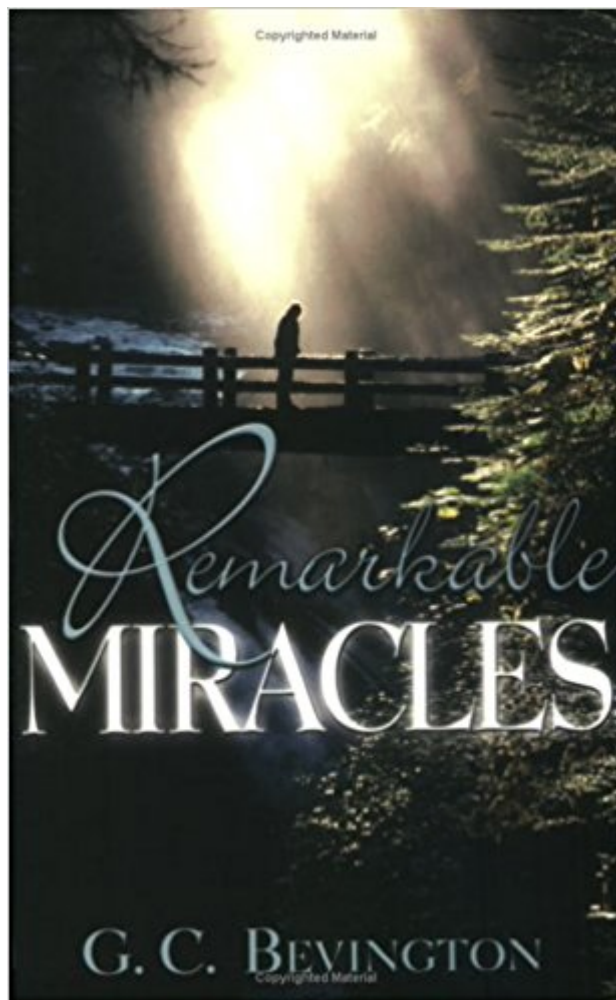

This man lived in the early 1900's. He walked everywhere and did the remarkable miracles because he had unfailing faith. The Lord provided for his meals and his accommodations, but he mostly slept in haystacks and hollowed out logs! He went for days without eating but didn't feel hunger when the Lord put a burden on him. As soon as the burden lifted, he felt hungry!

Mr. Bevington was a early 20th century "holiness" preacher. This is his story, written by his own hand, which describes the details of his remarkable life. Boiling it down to summarize, Mr. Bevington is a prayer warrior. He literally took the scripture "Pray without ceasing" to the nth degree, praying for days on end without stopping. This was his modus operandi and it unlocked the power of heaven for him. I have heard it said that "faith is the currency of heaven", and Mr. Bevington prayed without

ceasing in faith because he literally believed the word of God. If the word said it, he would pray until it manifested. His stories are remarkable and enlightening.
