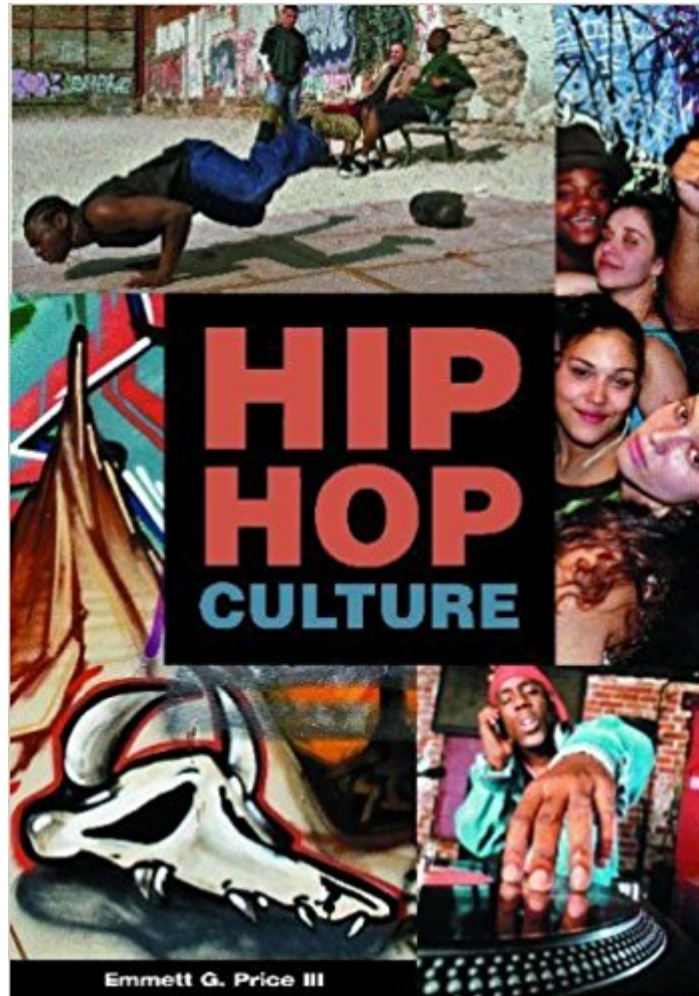




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Hip Hop Culture

Here is an attractive volume that covers the history and elements of "Hip Hop Culture" (the author uses capital letters to distinguish between Hip Hop Culture and hip-hop, the musical genre also known as rap) from its beginnings in the sixties through mid-2005. The first section of the book consists of a series of four essays, for example, "Issues in Hip Hop," which has subsections on "Can East Coast Hip Hop and West Coast Hip Hop Coexist?"
