

Three great Elvis Cole/Joe Pike novels for this price would be a good deal but with the great narration this becomes a very good deal. They are abridged versions but it's hard to identify exactly what was cut and the continuity is unaffected by the abridgement. Listen to them in order. I inadvertently brought only the last two books on a car trip so my wife was a bit lost as to Elvis' relationship status. The profane in Watchman was a bit shocking as I tend to just ignore that in print, hearing it out loud was harder to ignore. It fit with the character but might benefit from an explicit content mention.

I bought these for my husband. He is a shuttle driver for Tyson and drives 12 hour days all over Arkansas. So when he is on the road it helps him to pass the time to listen to books. He really liked all three of these stories. They were well worth the money.

Robert Crais is my absolute favorite author. He writes characters with depth on the same level as Stephen King (even the minor players are filled with delectable quirks). I've recommended and/or given his books to many people to read, and I've yet to have anyone come back with anything less than rave reviews. He has a great mix of suspense, comedy, action, and heart; all while never falling victim to any "slow spots" overblown with descriptive prose or rambling inner dialogue. The only negative thing that can be said is that his next book never comes fast enough!

Two thirds of the books were blank. First book was just fine. We took it on a seven hour road trip and watched scenery quietly for the last three hours. I have never returned an purchase so I am not starting now but I probably will never buy electronics again.
