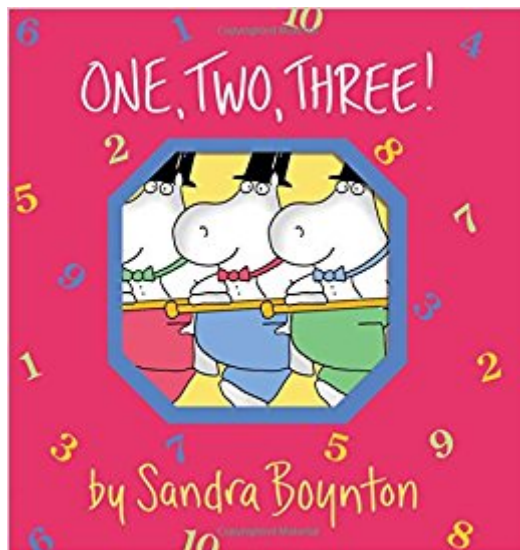

What can one say about Sandra Boynton. I am pretty sure we have every single kids book she has written! My autistic son, at 16 STILL loves for me to read him her books. They are his go to night time books. We have read them so many times, I think we all know them by heart. This is an upbeat little book about counting and as with all her writings, easy paced, quick read and fun. This particular book was purchased for my granddaughter (although our copy needs to be replaced as it is so worn!) I paired this with a stuffed hippo and she loved it. I am biased, I know, because I just love Sandra Boynton books as they make my boy smile.

We've been collecting Boynton books for about 6 months. When my 2 1/2 year-old grandson visits, he'll grab an armful and lie in bed with me so that I can read to him before his bedtime. Very often, I'll finish a Boynton book and he'll say, "Do again." The books are sturdy, introduce good concepts (for example, feelings ("What's Wrong Little Pookie?"), counting numbers, opposites, etc. But here's the dirty little secret, I buy these books as much for myself as for him. They're hysterical! The droll facial expressions of her characters, the situations in which they find themselves (come on, a turkey with a shoe on its head; two rats buying hats?). My 60-something husband still has the Dr. Seuss books his grandmother read to him when he was little. I'm thinking Boynton's books will be passed on, too.

If you like Sandra Boynton, you'll love this book. It rhymes, it helps kids learn to count, and it's cute

and funny. I am a big fan of this author. Her stuff is clever, which is important when your toddler wants it read to her for the 10,000th time...I say this as both a parent and an author: some children's books are so painfully inane that you'd rather jump out the window than read them, much less read them the many, many times your kid may demand. Mercifully, Ms. Boynton's books never meet that description. It may look easy to rhyme a few words and fill up a board book, but there's something of an art to it. Sandra Boynton is a master of that art. This is a cute and fun book that you and your kids will enjoy.

I bought this for my 13 month old son so we can read short books and get him used to reading. All of Sandra Boynton's books are excellent.
