

Magic Tree House CD Edition Books 17-24 Some of these titles didn't sound very fun, like Civil War and Revolutionary War, and Titanic. I had some reluctance to listening to these. However the author handled each one with her usual delicacy. In Civil War, the children see wounded soldiers and are moved to do what they can to help. IN Revolutionary War they see how the soldiers are suffering but also how brave and determined they are. After listening to Titanic I said "this story makes me feel sad." My son said "Yeah, it makes me feel sad too. But Jack and Annie helped them out". So I

think these stories are great adventures that also help us get in touch with our sadness about terrible things that happen. In Buffalos before breakfast, Jack is left thinking about how all the wonderful native indians life style will disappear. He is sad but reconciled. Each group of stories has a theme. These 8 deal with tragic events but in a way that is positive and life affirming.

My grandkids loved listening to these stories in my car. They read a lot, but hearing it like this was fun. They listened to them repeatedly. I wish they had this series when I was young! I think it is more difficult to find books boys will like. These are good for both girls and boys.

Great series, kids love listening in the car. The only thing I wish they would change is to not start a new book midway through a CD. Our 6yr old loves these books and 8 year enjoys them but it is a bit young for her now.
