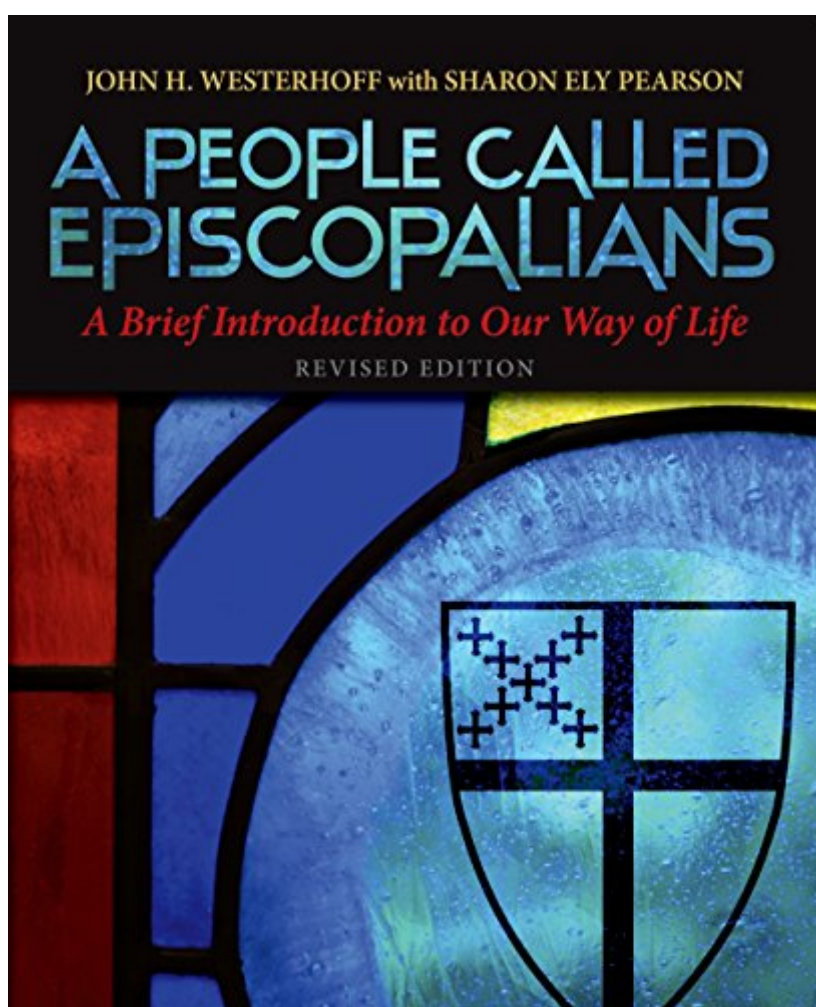


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A People Called Episcopalians: A Brief Introduction To Our Way Of Life, Revised Edition
