

I bought this for my mother, she is 70 and VERY good in maths and in Sudoku, she likes this one, she uses this, and another Sudoku book and board I also bought for her, every day and keeps her entertain. Print is big enough to read.

Of all the puzzle books available today, KENKEN is definitely the most challenging. This collection is truly well put together, with easy puzzles to introduce the concepts, then fairly rapidly progressing to much harder puzzles. You don't need to be a mathematician, but you do need to use your analytic and deductive skills. The book paper stands up to multiple erasers; and believe me, you will need them. The thrill of solving a particularly difficult puzzle is well worth the time.

Will Shortz puzzle books are wonderful. They are always progressively challenging from the easy to hard ones.
