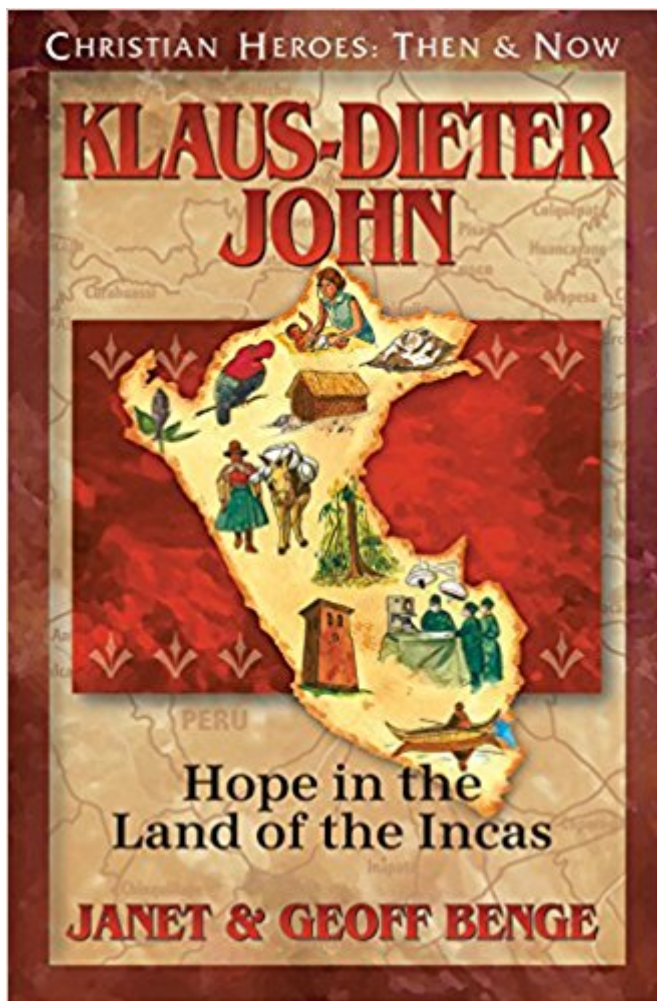


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# Klaus-Dieter John: Hope In The Land Of The Incas (Christian Heroes: Then & Now) (Christian Heroes Then And Now)
