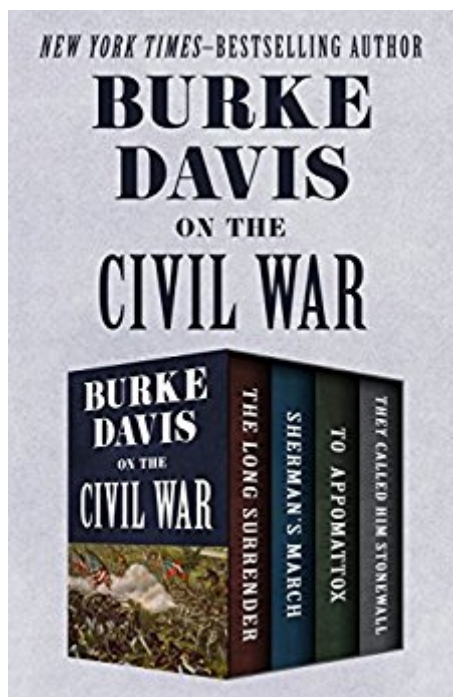




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Burke Davis On The Civil War: The Long Surrender, Sherman's March, To Appomattox, And They Called Him Stonewall
