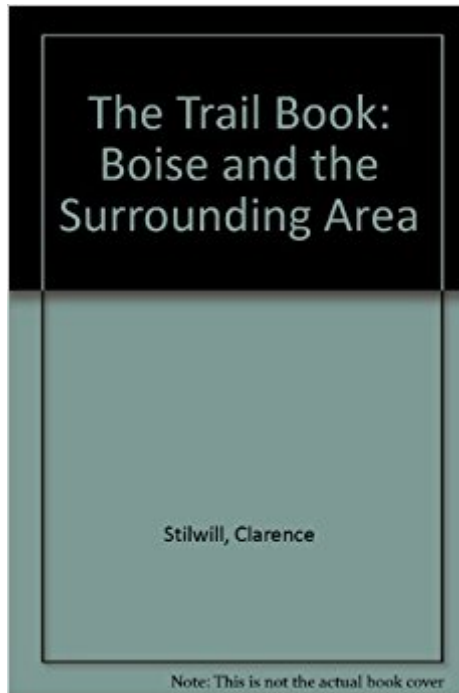

About the Crooked River Trail: "This out-and-back hike follows a crooked path down the Crooked River, a scenic waterway with enough twists and turns to justify its name. For a shorter hike of 2.5 miles round trip, turn around at the river crossing . Note: Depending on the water level, this can be a difficult crossing that generally requires wading. Fallen trees before and beyond this point are an alternative. There are good camping spots along the east bank and productive fishing throughout the river." -- Excerpted from The Trail Book for Boise and the Surrounding Areas Boise-A group of dedicated researchers spent most of this past summer hiking and camping the Treasure Valley, so you'll know what to expect if you plan a trip. The authors cataloged their findings and combined them with maps and photographs in newly released "Trail Book for Boise and the Surrounding." It's billed as a comprehensive, year-round recreation guide for hikers, bikers, skaters and xc-skiers and it delivers. The book packs more than 200 easily browsed pages of maps, photographs, trail descriptions and useful information, including distances, elevation gains, and difficulty ratings. It comes in a waterproof, zippered binder and there's room to add a compass, waterproof matches and other small, indispensable items. The binder format allows for future expansion and the tidy package even includes a plastic sleeve for protecting the removable pages when you don't have room for the whole guide in your pack. This book also includes an appendix of recommended companion reading, common-sense planning and packing information, a list of advisory phone numbers and information on what to do in an emergency. The quality of the photographs could be

improved and the plastic sleeve should be punched to allow for binding with the pages on the rings, but these are very minor nit-picks, and may well be addressed in later issues. The book follows on the heels and format of their successful Sun Valley book. -- From the Idaho Press-Tribune, November 9, 1995, by J.G. Kelly. Each book is created from the ground up. Trails are newly hiked, photos taken, and information discovered or confirmed. Books include day hikes, parks, bicycle rides, beach walks, cross-country skiing, some horse trails, and could include some water routes where applicable. The cover is green vinyl with blue nylon trim & zipper with gray printing. Our format has a purpose. The zippered vinyl cover protects books while banging around in backpacks, trunks, panniers, or whatever. Pages may be removed and inserted in a supplied plastic sleeve for carrying on a hike and to protect the page from dirt and moisture. The three-ring binding also allows for additions and upgrades. Can be personalized with foil stamping on cover for an additional \$4.95. Most of our books are printed from rice paper plates on recycled paper using a water base environmentally friendly ink. Other than the covers all work is done at our Hailey location, much of it performed by hand, often by the same people who hike and write our books. -- From the Publisher

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
