

I've repeatedly used the Navpress Life Change series for Sunday school and Bible studies, and like them very much because of their approach to gleaning meaningful insight. This Kindle version does that too, but I find it just a bit more difficult to navigate. The format is just slightly different than that of the hard copy version. This means that as I lead a group who are using the paperback, I need to take care to identify where I am in the study. There are no page numbers in the Kindle version. On the other hand, with this Kindle version I have gained the ability to copy and paste the questions to a word document, and I can type my answers to the Word document, for use as I lead the group. This eliminates writing the answers by hand, and dealing with what is often limited space.

This book series is very exegetical and unbiased. Everyone whom I've shared them with has liked them. I'm working on attaining the whole collection slowly.
