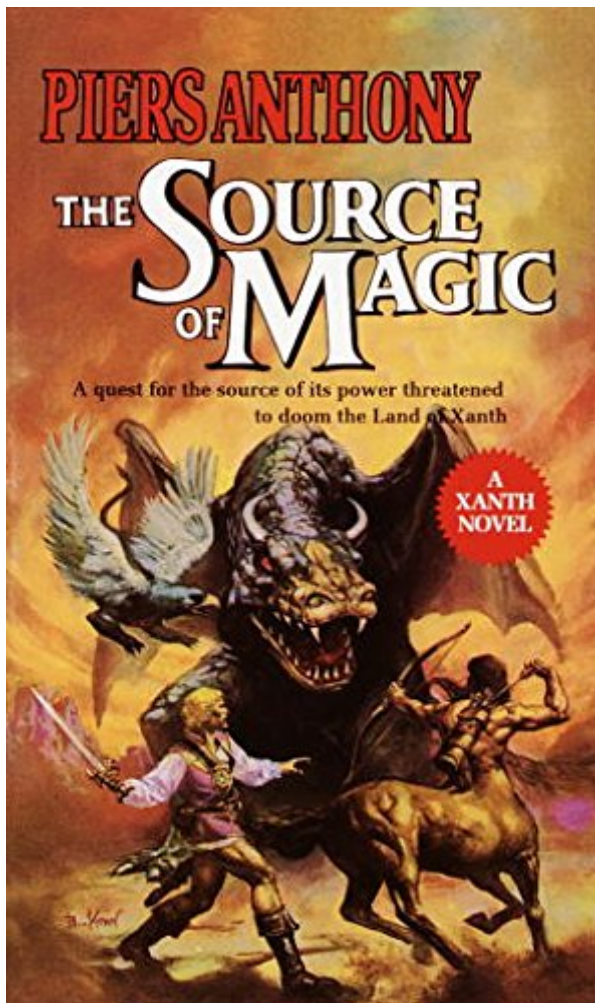

I couldn't handle the character development for this book or a Spell for Chameleon. The characters - the females especially - are SO one-dimensional. The author has them saying and doing things that are illogical and are just transparently done to serve his story line. The plot proceeds along quickly, and he has quite an imagination, but the places he takes us feel juvenile and self-serving. The female characters are vain and overly sexualized - makes me think the author hasn't had very many strong females in his life to give a good example. I tried and really wanted to like this, as it was recommended to me, but had to give up 3/4 through Source of Magic out of annoyance with the

constant weird plot twists and unrealistic characters.

I love Piers Anthony books. This book is one of many in this set. He makes you use your imagination a lot through the whole book. He takes the simplest thing and turns it into something else. This book is so much fun to read. I read this book every chance I got. I couldn't wait to find out what was going to happen.
