

The south side overlaps the northern side of the map at Galway on the west and Dublin on east, covering the remainder of the country including the cities of Limerick, Tralee, Cork, and Waterford. Ireland's lush green landscape is a result of its temperate, oceanic climate. The island's geography is mostly comprised of a central plain surrounded by relatively low-lying mountains. Coastal regions vary from sandy beaches to towering cliffs that rise hundreds of feet above the pounding surf. Castles, churches, abbeys, monasteries, and Neolithic sites abound, offering travelers a remarkable variety of opportunities to explore Ireland's rich and ancient cultural history. Every Adventure Map is printed on durable synthetic paper, making them waterproof, tear-resistant and tough • capable of withstanding the rigors of international travel.
