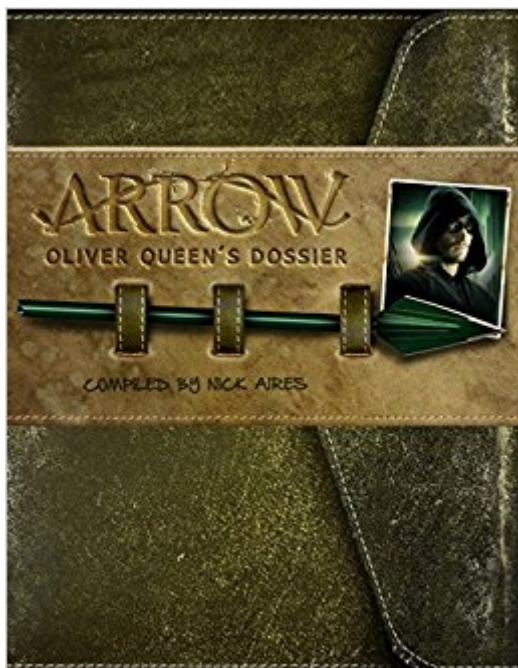


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Arrow: Oliver Queen's Dossier

I received this book on 10/18/16 and I am very pleased. It is cut into 10 sections I haven't full looked through all of it. It is impressive though. It is a good buy. If you love Arrow like I do you will enjoy this.

This book is amazingly designed. I really enjoyed the character tidbits, photos and biographies. My only real nit-pick is the glaring omission of Sin, who was a side-kick to Roy Harper and adoptive sister of Sara aka Canary. She played a pivotal role in Season 2, stopped Canary from killing Roy when he was on Mirakuru and during the uprising against Brick. It was Sin that alerted to Lance that the woman dressed as Canary during the uprising was NOT Sara, so I really don't understand why she was not included. This would have received five stars if she had been listed. However, if you are an "Arrow" fan, you will definitely want to add this to your bookshelf.
